Place Sainte-Foy and Saint-Romuald Carrefour Cochon Dingue restaurants are part of the Restos Plaisirs Quebec's Group. This group owns several restaurants addressing different thematics.

OBJECTIVES

The Group was looking for a solution to improve the productivity and profitability of its restaurants, while reducing various costs, including those associated with waste management. The whole thing was also to be innovative and a precursor in obtaining a green technology compliant with their social and environmental involvment.

90% reduction in usage of plastic bags

Full compliance with Quebec's organic waste law (2020 - 2022)

Recovery of food waste into biogas and reduction of greenhouse gases

RESULTS

To meet those needs, a holding tank was installed outside the buildings, one below the terrace and the other under a bike path. SoluRobots have been integrated in the heart of kitchen layouts to simplify food waste management.

Diversion of 63,67 m3 of food waste from landfills and incineration. The **equivalent of 101,872 tons of CO2** or a total of **27 cars on the road** for a year
